



Notification of the Department of Cultural Promotion

Re: Measures for Protection of Complainants,
Whistleblowers, or Those who Cooperate in Fraudulent Information Investigation of the
Department of Cultural Promotion

In order to prepare the plan for the improvement of the assessment of morality and transparency in the government agency operations of the Department of Cultural Promotion in an orderly manner, Department of Cultural Promotion hereby establishes measures to protect the rights of complainants, whistleblowers, or those who cooperate in the fraudulent information investigation as follows:

1. Department of Cultural Promotion takes into account the privacy and safety of complainants, whistleblowers, or those who cooperate in the fraudulent information investigation. In this regard, they have the right to choose whether to disclose their own personal information or not, including name, surname, address, or other information that can be identified, if they see that the disclosure of such information may cause insecurity or any impact on their own or their close ones.

2. Department of Cultural Promotion keeps complaints and related information confidential, primarily taking into account the safety and damage of complainants, whistleblowers, or those who cooperate in the fraudulent information investigation, including any person involved, unless there is a need to disclose as required by law.

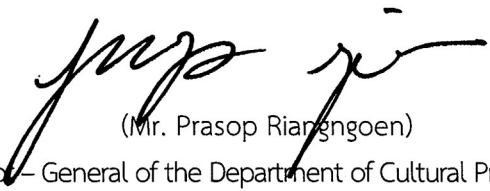
3. Department of Cultural Promotion will provide protection for complainants, whistleblowers, or those who cooperate in the fraudulent information investigation, to avoid any harm or any consequences from such unfair practices arising from complaints, whistleblowing, or cooperation as intimidation, threat, retardation, disruption of work, or acts of harassment.

4. Department of Cultural Promotion will provide protection for complainants, whistleblowers, or collaborators in the fraudulent information investigation who are affected by such actions as intimidation, threat, retardation, disruption of work, harassment, or other unfair treats. This can be reported directly to the supervisor.
