



Notification of the Department of Cultural Promotion


Re: Honest Intention for Corruption Prevention of the Department of Cultural Promotion

Department of Cultural Promotion, by the Director – General, executives, government officials, government employees, permanent employees, and personnel of the Department of Cultural Promotion, have an honest intention to set a standard for transparency, accountability, freedom from operational corruption, organizational morality culture, operational ethics, and corporate communications, as a guideline for the work of personnel and as a value for the Department of Cultural Promotion or its personnel to comply along with other rules and regulations in order to establish the organization of transparency with transparent and fair services for service recipients and with the improvement of the operational quality of the Department of Cultural Promotion.

Therefore, in order to achieve the goal of the corruption prevention, Department of Cultural Promotion shall proceed as follows:

1. Administrate and operate good governance by aiming to meet the needs of the people with righteousness and fairness;
2. Raise consciousness and encourage value and attitude of the personnel of the Department of Cultural Promotion to adhere to the principles of morality and ethics and to apply the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy to their work and living.;
3. Encourage private and public organizations to participate in cultural operations. and to receive information in all forms of activities;
- 4 . Promote and launch a campaign for the corruption prevention and suppression and cooperate with relevant agencies; and
- 5 . Promote the resistance and surveillance of all forms of corruption with strictness and high punishment measures against corrupters and related people.
